

Part 2: Working with Figures

Image Figures

You can drag images from the Finder or a browser web page into Curio. By default they are displayed with a preview image, as shown below.

Right-click on the image and choose Show Caption to enable preview captions. This can also be toggled using the Display tab in the Shape inspector. The caption can be any text, not just the image's file name and can be within the shape bounds or outside.

On the right, we're showing the same figure as an icon name. Right-click and choose *Show as Icon* to do this, or use the Display tab in the Shape inspector. In the inspector you can control the size of the icon. If bigger than 128x128 then we show a QuickLook thumbnail of the file instead. In contrast to the preview caption, the icon text is always the file name.



All the Peanut image figures used throughout this project share the same underlying asset file stored within the project package.
